INQUIRY

Inquiry terms of reference

- To examine the investigation carried out by Strathclyde Police, under the direction of the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service, into the murder of Emma Caldwell, including:
 - (i) the investigative strategy and decision making;
 - (ii) the giving of direction by the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service
 - (iii) any steps which could reasonably have been taken and, had they been taken, might have resulted in the offender being apprehended and prosecuted at an earlier stage;
 - (iv) the roles and responsibilities of those involved; and
 - (v) any other factors relevant to the circumstances of the investigation and related prosecution and to make recommendations to address any finding in that regard.
- To examine whether any failures in training, procedures, operating models or systems of working contributed to failures (if any) by Strathclyde Police or the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service in relation to the investigation and to make recommendations to address any finding in that regard.

- To report to the Scottish Ministers on the above matters and to make recommendations as soon as reasonably practicable.
